- Most importantly, keep eye contact with the judges, SMILE 😊 & have a good time!

Organization & Presentation

- Have a strong and interesting introduction.
- Give a brief explanation of your presentation
- Don't forget to introduce yourself!
- Correct use of your materials.
- Make sure you have everything you need! (We will provide a lap top, projector, projector screen, easel & a table.
- Have plenty of visual aids. We like to see what you are talking about! (photos, props, charts, models, etc.)

Organization & Presentation Continued

Step 1

- Make sure your presentation has a logical sequence.
- Steps, illustrative material, and explanation coordinated.

Step 2

- Be able to explain the procedure.

Step 3

- **SUMMARY: SUMMARIZE YOUR KEY POINTS AND GIVE CREDIT TO YOUR SOURCES! (Where did you receive all of your information)?**

Citrus Psyllid causes serious damage to citrus plants and citrus plant relatives. Burned tips and twisted leaves result from an infestation on new growth. Psyllids are also carriers of the bacterium that causes Huanglongbing (HLB) disease, also known as citrus greening disease, spreading the disease to healthy citrus plants. Citrus greening is one of the most serious citrus plant diseases in the world. Once a tree is infected, there is no cure.
